GOSPEL REFLECTION

Half way through Advent we pause for a moment to celebrate Gaudete Sunday, a Sunday for rejoicing. Isaiah paints a picture of regeneration. The desert that once seemed to be dead is now bursting with life; eyes that lacked sight, ears incapable of capturing and holding sound, limbs without strength, and tongues devoid of speech are all given new life. There will be no death in that age of fulfilment, no limitations, no mourning. The Third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday (gaudete is Latin for "rejoice"). This day we reflect on the deep joy of God's profound grace and love, while anticipating the fullness of our spiritual rebirth that is made possible by the coming of Christ at Christmas. This anticipation is symbolized by the rose colour of the third candle in the Advent Wreath and the vestments. This joyful pause, itself symbolic, bears a message of hope. We are never alone amid the challenges of life. Rather, God's love and mercy are always with us beckoning us forward, offering healing, support, and renewal.
