Do I need to make a reservation for weekend Mass? Yes ✓

Commencing Wednesday 1 July, the number of people allowed inside a place of worship is now determined by the one person per 4 square metre rule. Therefore adhering to this rule, Christ the King church can accommodate a maximum of 120 persons per Mass. It is still a NSW government requirement to register all attendees to assist in contact tracing should it be required. Therefore the Eventbrite website will now allow 120 parishioners to register to attend their chosen Mass.

RITE OF ADMISSION TO CANDIDACY FOR ORDINATION AS DEACON

John Collins, our trainee Deacon, will be formally admitted to candidacy for the Diaconate on Saturday evening 22nd August by Bishop Vincent at the 5:30pm Mass. Admission to candidacy for ordination as deacon comes about by means of a special liturgical rite, "by which one who aspires to the diaconate publicly manifests his will to offer himself to God and the Church, so that he may exercise sacred orders. The Church, accepting this offering, chooses and calls him to prepare himself to receive a sacred order, and in this way, he is rightly numbered among candidates for the diaconate". Depending upon the numbers we are permitted to have in the church at that time because of Covid 19 restrictions (currently 120) parishioners are welcome to book and attend.



PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are now able to visit the housebound and those who are unable to attend a parish for Mass or Holy Communion and request it via phone confirmation. These ministers will need to observe social distancing and ensure at least 1.5 metres is maintained between them and those in their care as well as not attending if they are sick in any way. Ministers will also need to use hand sanitiser, prior to the distribution of Communion. Only Communion on the hand is permitted at this time. This will begin again from next Sunday 19 July.
