REFLECTION

Dianne Bergant CSA

The feast of the Holy Trinity brings us face to face with the foundation of our faith. The readings for today provide answers to the question: Who is God? They can really only suggest something about the mystery of God, and they can do this only indirectly. They call to mind some of the wonders that God has accomplished for us and in us. It is through reflection on these gracious divine acts that we can get glimpses of God.

The psalm declares that the harmony and interdependence that we see in creation point to a majestic creator responsible for it all. The account of the history of God's people reveals a God who desires to establish an intimate relationship with them, enters their history as protector and guide, and forgives disloyalty. Finally, Jesus teaches that God sent him into the world to save it, has made us adopted children through the Holy Spirit, and will ultimately clothe us in divine glory. It is from his teaching that we hear that the Son was sent by the Father, the Spirit, which was also his Spirit, proceeded from the Father and from him.



From our own experience, we know that God creates. because we are immersed in creation. We know that God saves, because we have been freed from the bondage of own demons. our experience tells us that God is with us, and that God is for us. Everything that we know about God declares that God is passionately in love with us, boundlessly so!



NEW COVID SAFETY PROCEDURE

As announced last week the Eventbrite registering system for weekend Masses will cease and next weekend registration will occur via the QR code utilising the Service New South Wales application on your smart phone. If you do not have a phone, wardens will invite you to register by recording your name and phone number/email address. It will be important for those who use the Service New South Wales application to show the wardens at the door the green tick on your phone as you enter and to remember to check out after you leave Mass. The wardens will still continue to count the number of attendees to ensure we don't go over 240 according to the two square metre rule. A device to assist in the counting will be given to the wardens. Many thanks for your cooperation so as we are able to keep to our Covid safety plan particularly as we are aware that the virus has not completely disappeared as we see in Victoria.
