ACOLYTES AND EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

The primary role of the Acolytes and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion is the distribution of Holy Communion to parishioners and others who are ill or unable

to attend Mass. This role is the essential part of our mission; however, our

participation is not only the distribution of Holy Communion, but to provide pastoral care to those who cannot participate in the Mass. We may be the only contact, with

the exception of the Priests, that these people have with the Parish.

An acolyte, who is an ordained Minister of the Church, also assists at the Altar

during Mass and on occasions may be called upon to conduct Holy Communion services when no Priests are available. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

assist at Mass with the distribution of communion.

Acolytes and Ministers are selected by the Parish Priest and are required to

undertake study in the protocols and procedures for the performance of their

duties.

#### CHILDREN'S LITURGY

Children's liturgy is conducted every Sunday during the school term at 10am Mass. The aim is to relate the gospel message at a level suitable to the children's age group and understanding.
