#### **REFLECTION** by Dianne Bergant CSA

This is 'Good Shepherd Sunday' and a particular focus taken today is leadership. Which voices do we follow? Why do we follow these voices and not others? Authentic leadership is rooted in authority, and authentic authority is the ability to author or bring life to birth. Genuine authority cherishes, guards and encourages the best in life; it provides rest and refreshment; it guides our steps; it nourishes us; it leads us to God. Peter is an example of authentic authority: he proclaims the truth, even if others find it hard to hear; he denounces error, even when this places him in jeopardy; he calls for a change of heart, even when it makes great demands.

Authentic leadership is patterned after the leadership of Jesus. It is gentle and familiar, like the true shepherd; it has won the confidence of those who follow, as did the true shepherd; it is committed to the enhancement of the lives of others, as was Jesus. Authentic leadership is willing to forgo its own needs and to deny its own interests in favour of the needs and interests of others.

Heavy demands are placed on those who follow authentic leadership. Those who follow the Good Shepherd must follow him in the dark valleys as well as to the refreshing streams. They must be willing to relinquish some of their own plans and selfdetermination and entrust themselves to his leadership. They must never forget that they are following a shepherd who has paid the ultimate price on their behalf.

Thanks to all the parents who attended the meeting last Wednesday evening in the Church which outlined the program for this year for children in Year four or above who have made their First Reconciliation. Resource materials can be collected from the parish office (not school office) from Monday 8th to Friday 12th May from 9am to 3pm If you are unable to collect

the materials during this time, please contact the parish office to arrange another mutually suitable time. A reminder that the children will be liturgically enrolled in the program at any one of the three weekend Masses: 13th (5:30pm) /14th May (8am & 10am). It is critical that the children attend one of these Masses. Please contact the parish office if you are unable to attend for some legitimate reason. First Holy Communion will be celebrated on the weekend of the 10th (5:30pm) /11th June (8am & 10am), fittingly on the feast of Corpus Christi, the King's Birthday Long Weekend.

#### GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION

Thank you to everyone who gave to the Holy Land collection on Good Friday. A total of \$1900.00 has been sent to the Holy Land Commissariat to be used by the Franciscan Friars for pastoral care in the Holy Land: Israel and Palestine, Egypt, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon, Rhodes and Cyprus.

#### PARRAMATTA DIOCESAN SYNOD

Bishop Vincent is convoking a Diocesan Synod which will be held from the 12th to 15th October 2023. A Synod is both an event and a process where clergy, consecrated, and the laity gather to discuss important matters relating to the life and mission of the Church. This Synod will gather clergy, religious, and the laity across our Diocese to listen, discern, and respond to the Holy Spirit through voices of the People of God in Western Sydney and The Blue Mountains. From May to July 2023, in the lead up to the Synod, all are invited to participate in deanery and parish listening consultations, organising time to discuss with family and friends, and engaging in opportunities to dialogue.

At Christ the King Parish, a listening consultation will take place on **Sunday**, **21st May from 7:00 to 8:30pm** and again on **Wednesday**, **24th May from 7:00 to 8:30pm** in the Parish Hall.

The Northern Deanery, which our parish belongs to, is hosting a consultation on Saturday 13th May from 7:30pm to 9:30pm at St John 23rd School Hub, 160 Perfection Ave, Stanhope Gardens. Parishioners are welcome to attend and contribute to this ongoing consultation and listening exercise. Bishop Vincent will be present at this gathering.

#### SUNDAY NIGHT SESSION CHANGE OF DATES

A series of presentations, seminars, workshops, discussions, and stories designed to invite adults (young and old) to grow and develop in their faith. Each session begins at 7.00pm and finishes at 8.30pm and is held in the CTK Parish Hall. Sessions are designed to provide an opportunity for participants to ask questions, share thoughts and ideas and learn new stuff. The aim of the sessions is to further develop a community of mature inquisitive Catholics at Christ the King. Everyone 16 and over is welcome to participate. Sunday Night Sessions are usually held on the 2nd Sunday of the month from February to November however, as the second Sunday in May is Mother's Day, the date has been changed to Sunday, 21st May. The Sunday in June has also been changed to 18th June due to the fact that the second weekend is the King's Birthday long weekend. #### GIVE 6 THINGS TO JRS FOODBANK OVER 6 WEEKS

Right now the Jesuit Refugee Service is supporting 150 families a week and the demand for help keeps growing. Many of the families that are served are not eligible for Centrelink, Medicare and don't have work or study rights. With the cost of living rising many are struggling to have enough food to get their kids through the week. Any and all support is greatly appreciated. To help keep everyone fed, parishioners are asked to donate one item a week:

Week 1: Cooking oil (1L - 2L bottles)

Week 3: Long life milk (1L bottles)

Week 2: Basmati Rice (1kg - 5kg bags) Week 4: Tuna in oil (425g cans) Week 6: Liquid laundry detergent

Week 5: Pantry essentials (Sugar, salt, instant coffee, tea bags) Items can be left in the Church foyer and will be taken by a member of the parish to the JRS office.
